

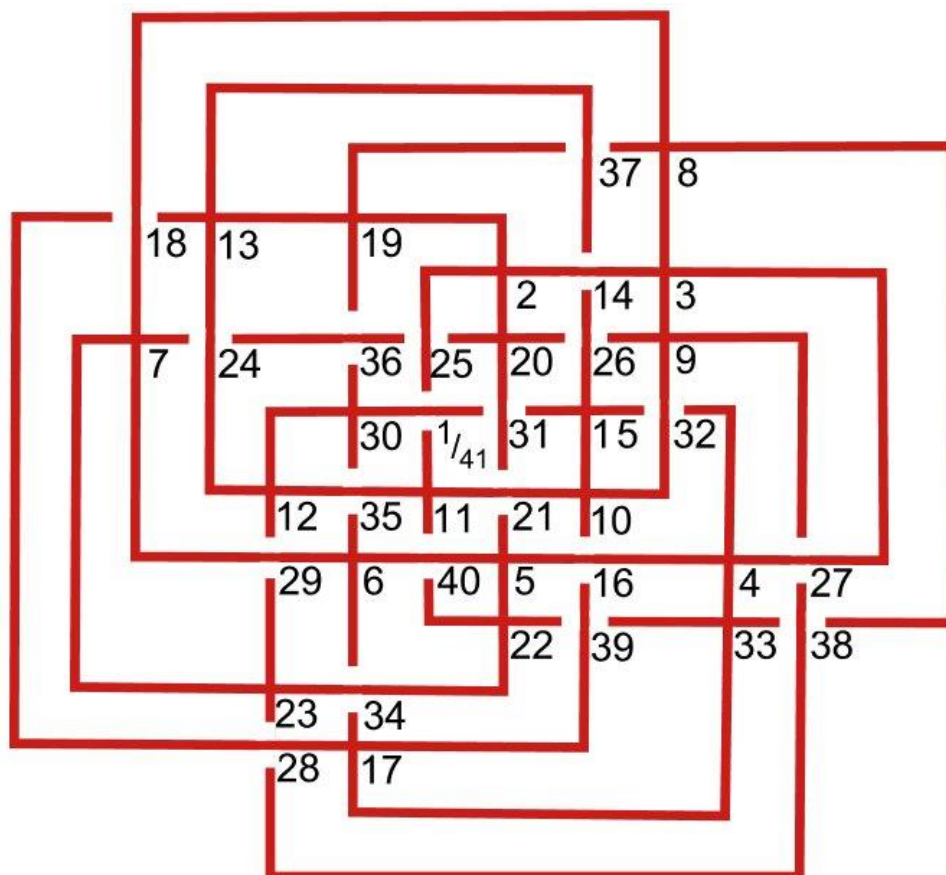

Round Knot (Ball Covering)

To make a covering for a golf ball pin diagram to soft piece of wood and knock a nail into every change of direction on diagram. The numbers refer to the crossing points

Take a piece of 3mm cord 9ft long. Starting at no.1 (middle of diagram), follow round the diagram going over any cords until you get to an under crossing e.g. the following No's

14,16,18,21,24,25,26,27,28,29,31,32,34,35,36,37,38,39,40,41.

When you have gone round the diagram once, pull the knot off the board and tighten it round the ball, **but keep loose at this stage**. When evenly spaced go round the ball again following original cord until back at start. If you require a two coloured ball introduce the 2nd colour between the two cords keeping to the original over and under pattern without crossing. You may wish to go round twice, this gives a nice even striped ball covering.

My thanks to the riggers of "HMS Victory" for giving me the original diagram and telling me how it was done.
