

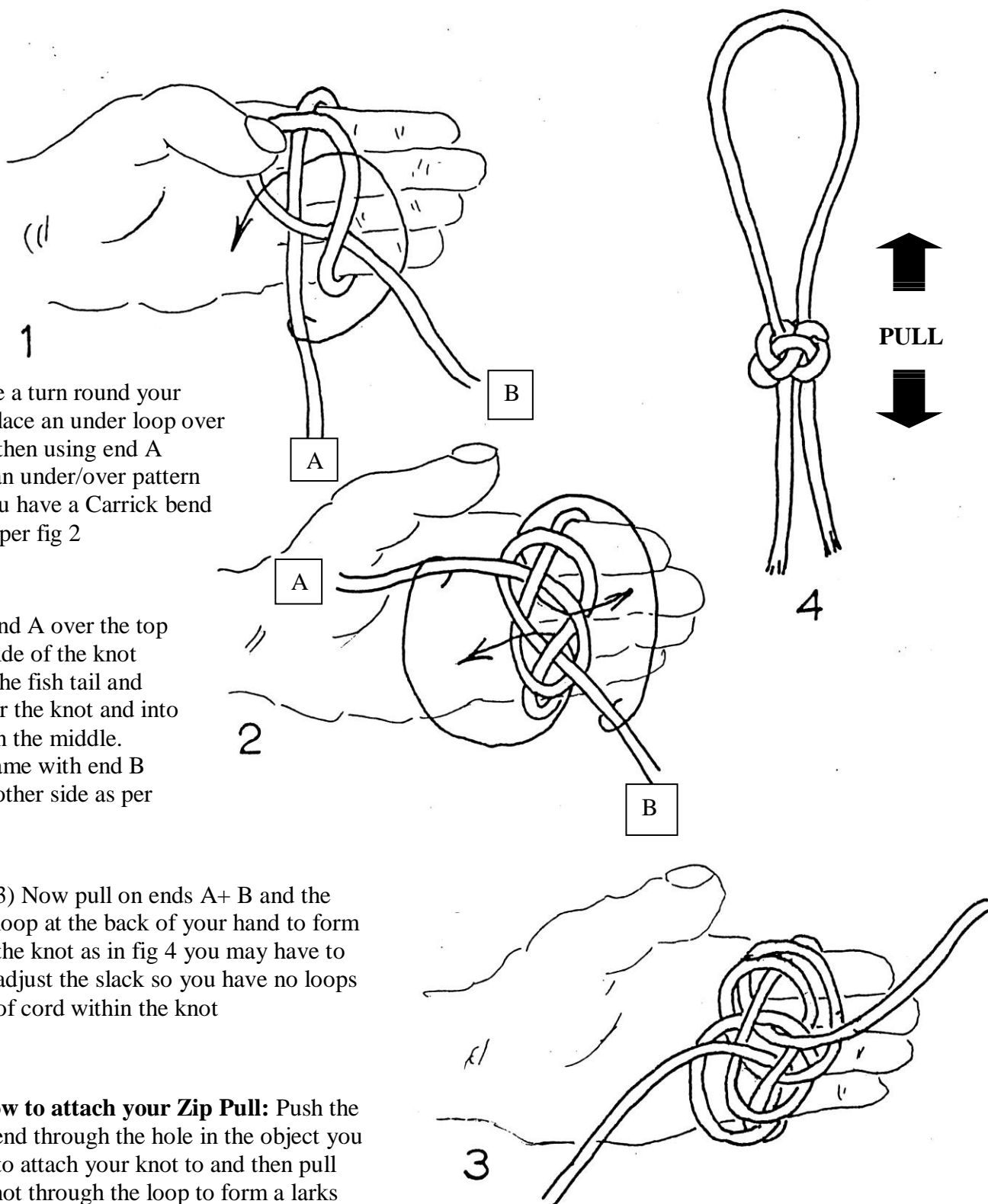

Lanyard Knot Project (Zip Pull)

Original Drawing By
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1) Make a turn round your hand. Place an under loop over cord A then using end A weave an under/over pattern until you have a Carrick bend knot as per fig 2

2) Take end A over the top to other side of the knot between the fish tail and then under the knot and into the hole in the middle.

Do the same with end B from the other side as per fig 3

3) Now pull on ends A+B and the loop at the back of your hand to form the knot as in fig 4 you may have to adjust the slack so you have no loops of cord within the knot

4) **How to attach your Zip Pull:** Push the loop end through the hole in the object you wish to attach your knot to and then pull the knot through the loop to form a larks head knot
